NOTES

- » LOCATIONS MARKED WITH A "?" ARE UNCERTAIN.
- » THE MOUNT OF OLIVES WAS A FOCAL POINT FOR MUCH OF THE LAST PART OF JESUS'S LIFE. THE GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE WAS ON OR AROUND IT (MAT. 26:30, 36 vs. LUKE 22:39), AND BETHPHAGE WAS ALSO NEAR IT (MAT. 21:1; LUKE 19:29).
- » JOPPA, LYDDA, AND DAMASCUS ARE NOT MENTIONED IN THE GOSPELS BUT ARE IMPORTANT PLACES IN ACTS.
- » JESUS GOES UP ON SEVERAL UNNAMED MOUNTAINS IN THE GOSPELS (FOR EXAMPLE, MARK 9:2 AND LUKE 6:12). HE PROBABLY OFTEN WENT UP MOUNT TABOR IN GALILEE, AND IT IS POSSIBLE THAT THE TRANSFIGURATION OCCURRED ON MOUNT HERMON.
